ABOUT THE PIECE

Ah, Moon of My Delight! depicts the human obsession with love and the inevitable mortality of all living things. We often see the moon as a symbol of uncertainty and cyclical change, and that is absolutely its role here. Throughout the piece, expressions of love are repeatedly made towards the moon but left without reciprocation. The music wanders through different worlds which depict a deep emptiness and instability within, to reflect this unanswered desire. Drones in the low end and echoing voices create mysterious soundscapes, as tensions rise throughout the piece. The music reaches its darkest point near the end and begins to fall apart in a desperate attempt at finding an answer, before finally arriving at a point of complete acceptance and solace. In the words of author Ivan Granger, "the individual self – the little self or the ego – disappears in the light of illumination. The moon rises, it shines, but there is no "you" to be found within that light."

ABOUT THE COMPOSER

The music of Iranian-Canadian composer **Hirad Moradi** (b.2003) takes listeners on a journey into the profound and visceral emotions that define our human experience. Drawing inspiration from a diverse array of sources —from jazz and metal to electronic music, visual arts, and poetry, Moradi crafts a uniquely innovative fusion of Persian and Western classical music that explores cultural intersectionality, while retaining distinct individuality.

Driven by a passion for artistic collaboration, Moradi's music has been performed across North America and Europe by groups such as the Dior Quartet, Talea Ensemble, Mostly Modern Orchestra, AMF Orchestra, University of Toronto Wind Symphony, and many more.

Currently, Moradi acts as conductor and executive director of the *Blank Canvas Sound Collective*, an independent organization and chamber orchestra focused on promoting and performing new music. In addition to this ambitious project, Moradi actively performs as a pianist and percussionist with several ensembles across Canada and the U.S.
