Michael Nunes is a Canadian composer and horn player from Sherwood Park, Alberta. He has performed as a soloist with the Hannaford Street Silver Band and the Westside Chamber Players, and performed with organizations such as the Edmonton Symphony Orchestra, the Aspen Music Festival, the National Youth Orchestra of Canada, and the Brott Music Festival. Previous commissions include the Edmonton Symphony Orchestra and the National Academy Orchestra of Canada, and his vocal and operatic works have been performed and recorded by the Juilliard School Vocal Arts Department, Green Room Sound Collective, and the Concreamus Chamber Choir. He is a current substitute musician with the New World Symphony. Michael holds a BMus from the University of Toronto, and is pursuing an MMus degree at The Juilliard School studying with Erik Ralske.
